

TLAP (Think local, act personal) is a group of 30 national organisations that are working together to change adult social care.



TLAP brings together organisations that include:

people who use services



carers



people who run services



central and local government.



They work together to help people have better lives through more choice and control over the support they use.



This is often called **personalisation**.

We started when we were involved in 2 projects for the Department of Health.

We were involved with TLAP from the start. We have members on their management groups and give them information about our sub groups.
